In order to create a positive academic environment where understanding, discipline and order prevail, DNS administration has developed the following “Code of Conduct” to be read, understood and signed by students and parents.

## CODE OF CONDUCT

We ask that our students kindly abide by the following rules:-

### A. PUNCTUALITY

Be on time for daily early morning assembly (7:40 a.m.). Late students will not be tolerated and measurements will be taken against them. Violators from Grades 7 → 12 will be penalized by deducting one mark from the behavior each time a student comes late.

### B. UNIFORM AND APPEARANCE

- Girls :**
1. School's uniform is compulsory.
  2. Wearing the "Abaya" in the school premises is not allowed.
  3. Black, maroon, white or gray jackets are allowed during winter.
  4. Wearing sports uniform is allowed only on the day when you have PE classes.
  5. Only swimming suits provided by the school are to be worn during swimming lessons.
  6. Hair should be off the face, tied back if long enough. Coloring the hair is strictly forbidden.
  7. Make-up, long nails and nail-polish are not allowed.
  8. No gold jewelry or trinkets are allowed. If any jewelry items are worn, they will be confiscated.
  9. Only plain black low-heeled shoes with laces or a buckle are allowed.  
**Sandals and slippers are not allowed.**

- Boys :**
1. School's uniform is compulsory.
  2. Black, maroon, white or gray jackets are allowed during winter.
  3. Wearing sports uniform is allowed only on the day when you have PE classes.
  4. Only regular haircuts are allowed. Violators will be sent home and must have a normal haircut before they are admitted back into school.
  5. Only plain black shoes with laces or buckle are allowed.

**C. HYGIENE :**

1. Take care of personal hygiene. Hair, fingernails, teeth etc. should be clean.

**D. CLASSROOM CONDUCT:**

1. In class, be quiet, listen carefully and work hard.
2. Do not eat or drink inside the classroom.
3. Do not enter any other classrooms.
4. Do not leave your classroom between periods.
5. Do not leave your classroom in case of emergency without your teachers' pass card.
6. Students must commit themselves to utter honesty, and never use or borrow anything without the owner's permission.
7. Do not use any unacceptable stickers on books, bulletin boards or doors. Suitable files for work, without any pictures of pop-stars, etc. should be used.
8. White correctors are not allowed in school & will be confiscated if seen.
9. Keep your classroom clean and tidy.
10. Do not scribble on your desks and chairs.
11. Do not stay in the class during break time.

**E. OUTSIDE CLASSROOM CONDUCT:**

1. Bring to school all required items, stationeries & books.
2. Obtain permission from the supervisor before going to the administration/clinic.
3. Do not go into the library or inside the classrooms during breaks without the supervisor's permission.
4. Do not leave the school grounds without permission during school hours.
5. Respect for all administrative staff and teachers in the school is expected from all students.
6. Decent behavior on school transport and in front of school is expected from all students.
7. Do not drive to school unless permitted by the principal.
8. Do not go to bus areas unless authorized.
9. Play in assigned areas of the playground, not in the bathrooms or hallways.
10. Climbing on fences or trees, or climbing onto the roofs of the building is forbidden.
11. No fighting. No littering.

## GENERAL

1. **Tardy students will be penalized by deducting marks from their "Behavior Average".**
  2. **Mischievous and lazy students who fail to perform their duties and meet the deadlines in submitting their assignments will be dealt with seriously.**
3. Absence from any examination will not be allowed and no re-test will be conducted unless the cause of absence is sickness which is confirmed and authorized by the administration.  
\*\*\* Weekly tests and pop quizzes are not to be repeated under any circumstances.
  4. All tests should be written in pen.
  5. Mobile phones are strictly forbidden (They will be confiscated).
  6. School should be attended regularly except during emergencies such as severe illness, accidents or urgent travel abroad. Students will not be admitted to their class without a medical report or a letter from the guardian justifying the reasons for their absences.
  7. Cameras, cassette recorders, CDs, MP3s or video films are not allowed in school unless specific permission is obtained.
  8. Eating chewing gum in school is not allowed.
  9. Do not bring any **"glass bottles"**, **"soft drinks"**, **"chips"** or **"fast food"** to school.
  10. Do not use any bad or foul language at all or fight with anyone inside or outside the classroom. "In case of not complying, the student may be expelled from school"
  11. Take good care of textbooks and copybooks; keep them neat and tidy.
  12. Bus students are expected to use the assigned bus only. Requests to change buses are not honored unless it is an emergency case and with a written note from the parents.
